## **Artist Talk by Laura Donefer at the Canadian Clay and Glass Gallery**

**Waterloo** - On March 16, the Canadian Clay and Glass Gallery will welcome Laura Donefer, one of Canada's most respected glass artists, as she discusses her body of work and a professional career that spans nearly three decades.

Donefer's work has been featured in many exhibitions at the Gallery, including the current exhibition, *WAR: Light Within/After the Darkness*. Her work, *Todesmärche Revisited: In Honour of Those Perished During the Death Marches*, is an installation of cast glass footprints – some taken from actual Holocaust survivors – located in the Donald and Pamela Bierstock Circular Gallery.
