ABOUT THE ARTWORK

Sharl G. Smith expands her beadwork to stunning installations using custom-made stainless-steel beads instead of traditional glass seed beads. In a medium often seen as "women's work" and thus subject to the disparity of value between male and female labour, Smith alters our perceptions with life-size public sculpture. The tiny details of traditional beading have become magnified. In the mirror-polished stainless steel, we also experience the addition of a clear reflection that multiplies and expands within the work. This mirroring also creates an additional implication of the viewer. The piece not only demands our attention through its scale but also reflects our own image back at us. As we explore the form, we find ourselves.
